



Three questions to ask at the holiday table this year

For Rosh Hashanah, Sukkot, Thanksgiving, or any time three generations sit down at once.

Tell everyone the day before to bring one old photograph. Then put your phone on the table and press record before the cake comes out. Ask the questions one at a time and let everyone talk over each other, because that is where the good parts are. Say the date and who is at the table at the start, so that in thirty years somebody knows.

2

Tell one family story that is vivid for you.

3

Show your photograph. Who is on it, where was it taken, and when?
